How we can help you get #WorkWise

We're Running a WorkWise employment project in partnership with St Mungos Broadway. It aims to help our tenants, who are keen to get back into work, get on the right track, by providing a service catered to their needs.

Who is eligible for the support?

- Lambeth Housing Management tenants affected by the size criteria (Bedroom Tax)
- TMO affected by the size criteria
- Must be in receipt of JSA, ESA, Income Support or Incapacity Benefit

Who are we working with?

- Local employment support services
- The Work Programme
- Lambeth Housing Management's own apprenticeship scheme
- Lambeth Council's employment initiatives
- FACE

Why WorkWise works well!

- Work Wise provides you with a **supportive one-to-one service** from a dedicated work coordinator – not a different person each time!
- They listen to **your** needs and what **you** are interested in doing.
- They provide you with **in work support** when you find a job.
- Help overcoming any barriers you may face getting back into work i.e. offending history, mental health disclosure, disability, medical conditions, etc.
- They will work with you to get you closer to what you want to do and **listen** to what you are interested in, in the short term and the long term.

What do you get from WorkWise?

Once registered with St Mungo's Broadway – you will have access to a wide range of opportunities:

Progression fund

Allows you to apply for up to £100 funding for something that will help you move into work or training.

Recovery college

Provides over 70 courses in Southwark – totally free and travel paid.

Dedicated basic skills team

Can help with literacy, numeracy and IT, as well as Dyslexia support.

Business start up support and access to funding.

Mentoring program

Tenants are matched with a dedicated employment mentor for 9 months.
